

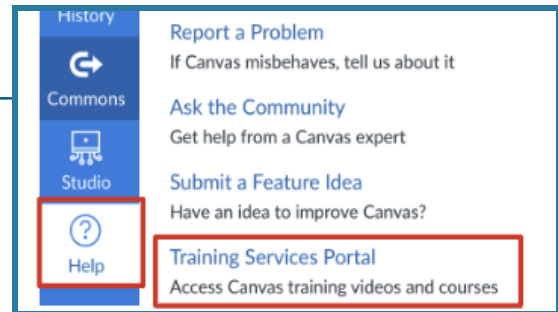
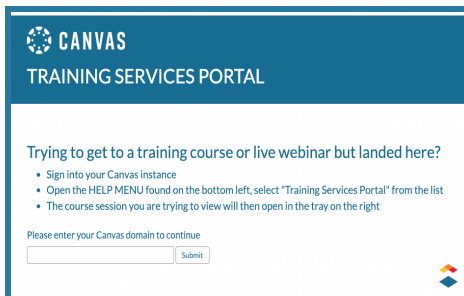
# Training Services Portal Guide

## Steps on How to Login and Navigate the Portal

### Log In

#### → Training Services Portal Access

The “Training Portal” button can be accessed through your institution’s Canvas help menu. The help area in Canvas is at the bottom of the Global Navigation Menu.

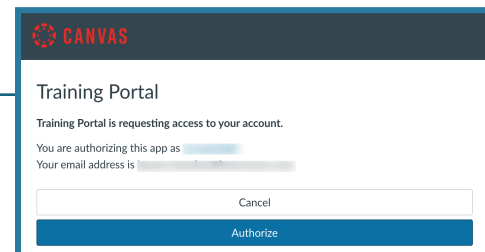


*Please note, the order of the links may differ in your help menu.*

If you are not logged into your institution’s Canvas instance you will be prompted to do so.

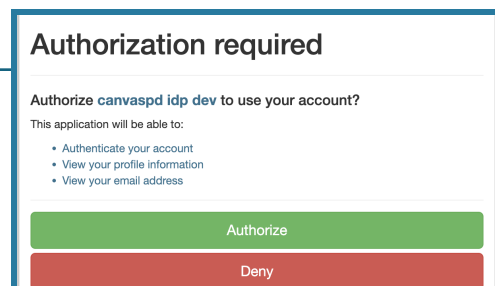
#### → Approve Access

Select the “Authorize” button to authorize your training account. This will appear each time you enter the Portal.



#### → Authorization Required

Select the green “Authorize” button to access the portal for Canvas training content. The portal is built in a Canvas instance using an external LTI and administered by Instructure. You will not see this request on future log-ins.

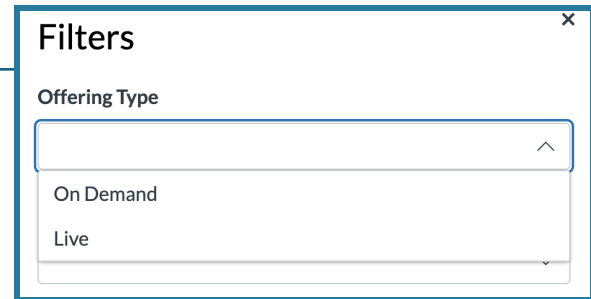




## Filtering Options

### → Offering Type

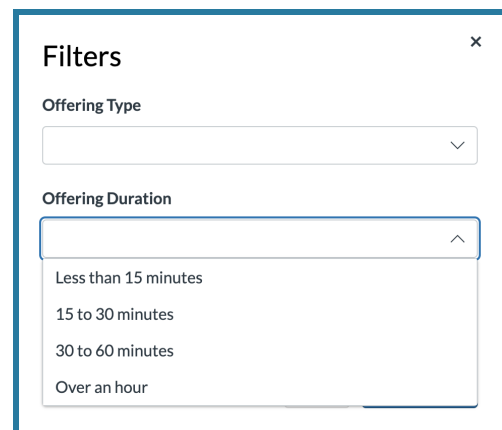
Filter through On Demand offerings by Offering Type. Users can select On Demand or Live to see applicable offerings.

### → Offering Duration

Filter through Courses and Learning Pathways by selecting the desired amount of time you want to spend on learning.

### → Tags

## Course Enrollment

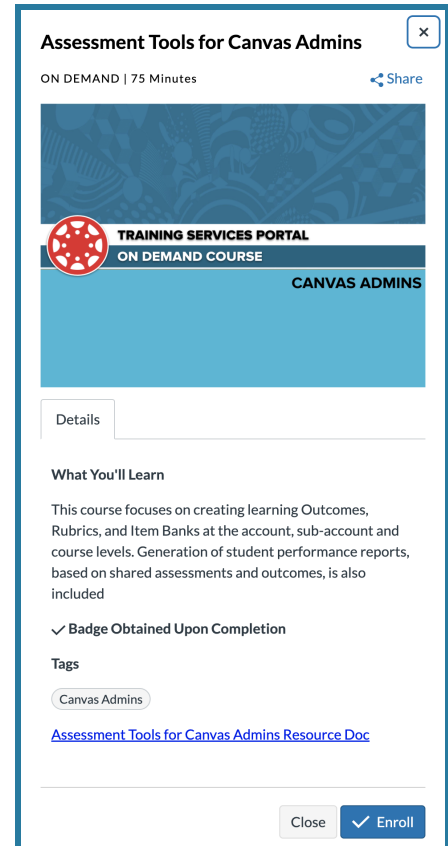
## → Enroll in an On Demand Training Course

View the list of offerings by scrolling left and right in the designated row. Please note that courses are split up by Higher Ed and K12. Once you find a title you wish to complete, select the card.

Once selected, the card will provide more detail including:

- Length of time
- Course Card image that communicates Intended Audience and Institution, if applicable
- Associated tags
- A link to the course's Resource Document

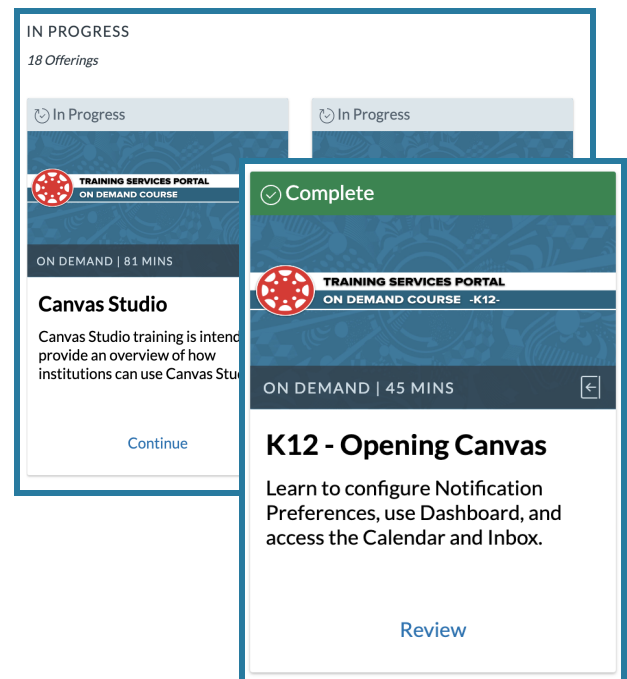
Select the Enroll button to be automatically enrolled in the course.



## → In Progress / Completed

Offerings that you have already enrolled in or have started will appear in the top row titled "In Progress". Select "Continue" at the bottom of the course card to navigate to the On Demand course. The course will open in a new tab.

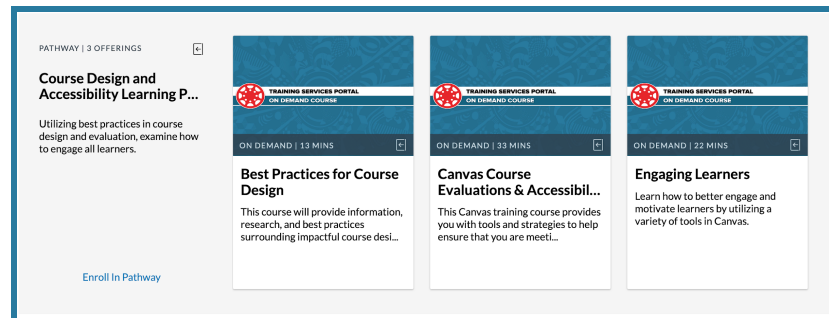
Once a course has been completed, a green "Complete" banner will appear at the top of the course card. The course will no longer appear in the "In Progress" row at the top of the screen. If a user would like to review any of the material covered in a complete course, simply select "Review" at the bottom of the course card. This will take the user back to the On Demand course. A Badge will be awarded upon course completion with a final grade of at least 80%. This badge can be seen in the Backpack of your Canvas Credentials Account.



## Pathway Enrollment

### → Enroll in a Learning Pathway

A Learning Pathway is a series of related On Demand course offerings. Courses that are a part of a pathway can be taken alone or as part of the pathway. Once you find a Learning Pathway of interest, select the arrow in the top right corner to see a description of the pathway and which course offerings are included in the pathway. When you enroll in a Learning Pathway, you will be automatically enrolled in all courses in the pathway (if you have not already completed any of the pathway courses by itself) and those courses will now appear at the top of your screen in the “In Progress” row. When enrolled in a pathway, it will say “Enrolled” at the bottom of the pathway information row.



### → Completion

When you have successfully completed all of the courses in the Learning Pathway, a green “Complete” banner will appear at the top of each pathway course. The pathway itself will now have a green check mark in the bottom left corner accompanied by “Pathway Completed”. A Badge will be awarded upon pathway completion and can be seen in the Backpack of your Canvas Credentials account.
